Vegetable Pizza

- 2 packages of crescent rolls (8 count)
- 2 each Philadelphia cream cheese
- 1 pkg. Hidden Valley Ranch home style dressing
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 3/4 cup Grated Cheddar Cheese
- 3/4 cup of broccoli (chopped fine)
- 3/4 cup of carrots (chopped fine)
- 3/4 cup mushrooms (chopped fine)
- 3/4 cup green peppers (chopped fine)
- 1/2 cup green onions (chopped fine)
- 3/4 cup tomato (chopped fine) (optional)

Spread the crescent rolls flat on a cookie sheet with each package side by side. Pinch the seams so as to make the dough like a flat solid square. Follow the directions for cooking the dough on the package. Cook and allow to cool.

In a mixing bowl, mix to an even consistency the mayonnaise. Cream cheese, and the ranch dressing mix. Once the bread has had a chance to cool sufficiently, spread the mix evenly across the top of the bread— be careful so as to not separate the layers of the bread. It is best to put the cheese mix in each corner and try to spread evenly towards the middle.

In another mixing bowl, mix all of the remaining ingredients (except for the cheese) and spread them evenly over the cheese spread and bread. Taking a piece of wax paper spread over top, gently smash the vegetables into the cheese/bread mixture. Store in the refrigerator until ready to cut and serve.

Remove from the refrigerator and spread the cheese (may take more than 3/4 cup depending upon personal taste) evenly over the vegetables. Cut into squares and serve.
